SENIORS' QUALIFICATION CRITERIA – TROPHY BOARD COMPETITIONS – 2023

To play in Seniors' Tuesday competitions a golfer must meet the following criteria:

- Have a current WHS handicap by virtue of submission of general play cards or a competition card
- Meet the Senior age criteria 60 years of age on the day of his first competition
- Be a member of the Seniors Section by virtue of having played a Senior competition

To win and be presented with any designated Seniors' Trophy, a player must continue to meet the Senior's qualification criteria. This requires any Senior to have played in at least three (3) Tuesday, Senior events in the running 12 months immediately preceding the date of the Trophy event in question.

One aspect of the "principle" of the Senior Qualification criteria has been amended (AGM, October 2022) in relation to our designated Trophy Events:

- To entitle a player not meeting the Senior qualification criteria to now be able to win the Prize Money allocated to their placing in such events, with all other placement money being adjusted to reflect the winning players' positions.

The Captain, Vice-Captain and Competition's Secretary will continue to retain the power to review circumstances surrounding the qualification criteria, for instance: long term ill-health or such other factors that might seriously impact on a player's ability to meet the criteria.
